Betty Jane (Stillwell) Krueger was born on January 4, 1955, in McAllen, Texas to the late Mr. Charles F. Stillwell and Mrs. Florence V. (Richter) Stillwell. She went to be with our Lord and Savior peacefully on Tuesday August 19, 2025. Betty trusted Jesus Christ as her own personal Savior after watching a Billy Graham crusade. This relationship with the Lord strengthened her life and gave her assurance of a heavenly home.

Betty was a servant at heart and helped care for her younger siblings while her parents worked. She helped out at St. Paul Lutheran Church in their after-school program and a kiddy college daycare center.

She went out of town to care for her future husband's sister's children while she was recovering from surgery. Betty then went on to work for Mexico Mission Ministries (Evangelical Mission Ministries now merged with Faith Baptist Mission). Serving many roles from office assistant, receptionist, secretary, custodian, guest apartment coordinator, etc., she was a faithful and diligent worker. She would be up there early to get envelopes addressed and ready for dated mailings. She always prepared for a "coffee time" in the office and during conference times she would often make special goodies for the enjoyment of all. The children of the missionaries lovingly called her "Aunt Betty". She would include them in her work as much as possible. Daily office devotions were routine and Betty always kept one of her Bibles handy in her office. Personal Bible reading was important to her. She also maintained the lists of detailed prayer requests the staff brought before the Lord.

Remembering names and prayer requests were a special ability Betty had. Even after retirement, her missionary and church friends and family counted on her being their "prayer warrior." She spent hours every day praying for people around the world.

Betty is survived by her loving husband David F. Krueger of 47 years 7 months and 5 days, also three sisters, two brothers and countless nephews and nieces.
