Candice Suzann Blair, 65, was called to her heavenly home September 13, 2016 at Kindred Hospital in Dallas, Texas after a lengthy illness battling Scleroderma, the rarest form of auto immune deficiency. She was born July 31, 1951 in Kansas City, KS to Robert and Dona Blair.

After graduating from Nacogdoches High School, she attended Stephen F. Austin State University, Nacogdoches, TX where she received her Bachelors degree. She did graduate studies at Texas Women's University and received her masters degree from East Texas State University, Commerce, TX. She began her teaching career at Dumas High School, Dumas, TX then moved to the Grand Prairie school district where she completed her 32 year teaching career, retiring in 2012. As well as teaching school she worked for the Dallas Morning News for 20 plus years.

She was preceded in death by her father Robert M. Blair, brother Stephen M. Blair, maternal grandparents Chester and Irene Kerns, and her paternal grandparents Lester and Helen Blair. She is survived by her mother and stepfather, Dona and Richard Smith, sister-in-law Fran Blair, her Aunt Karen Fossland and 4 cousins.
