She found retirement boring with little to do, so she started to substitute teach in Mission and Sharyland Schools. She attended and graduated from these McAllen schools: Lincoln Elementary, Travis Junior High and McAllen High. She lived at home while commuting to Pan American College, graduating from there on May 29, 1966 with a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary education. Carol was very fond of classical dancing, performing at many social events for the Mary Katherine Dance Studio and wild life. She could be seen daily feeding the birds and squirrels that visited her home. She had two extensive collections of ballerina dolls and hippopotamus of various compositions.
