Earl Donovan Beamsley moved on, on Friday, June 19, 2026. Growing up on the family farm in Pharr, he graduated from PSJA in 1967 and attended Pan American college and the University of Texas at Arlington. He returned to the Valley, where he began his work as a skilled carpenter and contractor. He eventually retired from contracting and joined forces with his wife as an owner-manager of Waugh's Nursery. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, travel and time with friends and family.

Earl gave with his whole heart, and it was one of the biggest hearts ever. He

was a stalwart supporter of his lifelong church, the People's Covenant church in San Juan, and of his many friends and family.
