Harold Frederic Block, 92 went to be with his Lord and Savior on December 3, 2015. He was preceded in death by his wife Naomi Lavern, whom he was married to for 61 years. Harold was born and raised in Mitchel Nebraska where he lived until joining the USMC at 17 to serve his country during WWII. During his years of service with the Marine Corp , Harold was a SBD Dauntless dive bomber co-pilot as well as a test pilot for the new F7F Tigercat . Upon his return home from the war, Harold attended Olivet Nazarene College in Kankakee Illinois where he met his beloved wife, Naomi. They settled in Decatur Illinois before moving to the Rio Grande Valley in 1962 where he lived for over 53 years. Harold worked in the dry-cleaning and construction industry until his retirement. He was a very active member of the Rio Grande Valley Church of the Nazarene. It is there he enjoyed being the song leader for many years as well as assisting missionaries on their way south to preach the Lord's word in Mexico and Central America.
