Jack T. Trammell passed away at his home in Alamo, Texas on Saturday, November 17th, 2018 surrounded by family. He is preceded in death by his wife, Ilse, of 49 years, and his parents David and Della Trammell.

After retirement, Jack and Ilse spent much of their time enjoying their second home in Westcliffe, Colorado, attending University of Texas events, traveling, and visiting with family and friends.
