The life of James Ridolfo, Sr. of Mission, TX, came to its finale when he fell asleep in death on June 25, 2022.

James, Sr., or Jim, as he was known to his friends, was born in Manhattan, NY on July 28, 1933. He was educated at the Universidad de Guadalajara and was employed as a civil engineer with Petróleos Mexicanos, supervising many industrial projects and pipelines throughout México. In 1964, he met Norma King in Monterrey, México. They were married for 40 years and went on to have 3 children.

When he decided to change careers, he studied to become a certified financial advisor and stockbroker, establishing Knorr Financial Services. Later, he reinvented his career again, becoming a Golden Corral® franchisee for 30 years, operating several restaurants throughout Texas. At the spry age of 88, Jim still came into the office every day and traveled weekly with James Jr. to manage his business.
