It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Joseph Kennedy Narro on January 1, 2025, at the age of 72. Joseph, better known to his friends as Joe or Pepe, was born on July 24, 1952, to Frank and Sonora (Bryan) Narro in Saltillo, Mexico.
