Larry Bruce Hill, 74, died Nov. 21, 2018 in McAllen, TX. He was born and raised in Danville, Illinois. After graduating from Danville High School, he enlisted in the Army Security Agency and was a volunteer to Vietnam. He graduated from Eastern Illinois University and returned to Danville to work for the Hyster Company. After 27 years with the Hyster Co., Larry left to become Vice President of Manufacturing for Mitsubishi-Caterpillar Lift Truck America in Houston, TX until his retirement in 2002.
