



Mark Christopher Russell

On November 16, 2022 after a sudden and brief illness, Mark Christopher Russell of Elgin, TX died in the DHR emergency room in McAllen, TX. He had spent the preceding two weeks helping his brother to care for his ill father, Mark Russell (McAllen) who passed away on November 13th just three days earlier.

Chris is survived by his mother, Paula Boothe and stepfather, Larry Wieland (Tucson, AZ), his brother James (Jamie) Russell (McAllen), girlfriend Michelle Moffitt (Elgin) and a number of aunts, uncles, and cousins.

Other family members of Chris who preceded him in death were his maternal grandmother Betty Boothe Halladay (Elgin) and his paternal grandparents, W.B. and Bette Russell (San Juan, TX).

Chris attended schools in McAllen and was a member of the McHi Class of 1988. He went on to become the lead guitarist in a few south Texas bands most notably Kalamity Jane which played many clubs and other venues mainly in the Valley and which had a very loyal and fervent following in the 90s.

After leaving his band days behind, Chris became a freelance graphic artist and in his mid-30s enrolled in a film school in the Los Angeles CA area. He later graduated cum laude from Columbia College Hollywood with a BA in Fine Arts with majors in film and television production.

There are no plans for any immediate services for Chris but celebrations of his life will be held later in Elgin where he had a number of friends and next spring

along the Laguna Madre where he loved fishing with his beloved brother Jamie.
