Marta Lujan, age 69, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 24th, at the Alfredo Gonzalez

Texas State Veterans Home in McAllen, TX, while courageously battling cancer.

On March 26th, 1952, Marta was born in Edinburgh, TX, to Vicente and Josefina Lujan. She

spent most of her childhood in La Pompa alongside her two brothers, three sisters, and countless

childhood friends. Marta Lujan was a graduate of McAllen Highschool, and following her

graduation, enlisted in the Army.

Marta was a proud Army Veteran and patriot. She completed her basic training at Ft. McClellan

in Anniston, AL. After basic training, Marta was stationed in Ft. Sam Houston and then at Ft.

Sheridan in Chicago, IL, where she eventually met her future husband, John Joseph Lyons. They

then accepted transfers to Natick, Massachusetts, before returning permanently to her beloved

and magical Rio Grande Valley in 1980. Marta Lujan married her Husband, John Joseph Lyons,

on June 24th, 1977, in McAllen, TX. They shared 39 years of marriage. Marta

spent 34 years as
a supervisor with the State of Texas Department of Health, where she created
lifelong friendships
