Pete Castillo, 79, passed away at his residence on November 6, 2018, surrounded by family and friends. He was born on June 29, 1939 to the late Dominga Hernandez and Arnulfo Castillo. While Pete started his career with McAllen Medical Hospital, he was known for his career in management with Chase Bank, (formerly Texas Commerce Bank and First National Bank) where he spent over 25 years. He was a member of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, followed by Holy Spirit Catholic Church.

His battle with Parkinson's started in 2009. Throughout this battle he was strong in his faith and maintained a positive attitude.

He was a devoted husband and father to his wife Bertie and daughter Debbie. He was an avid fisherman and hunter for most of his life. Pete enjoyed traveling with his family to the western parts of the United States. He loved taking scenic road trips.

Pete was preceded in death by both his parents (Dominga Hernandez and Arnulfo Castillo), his beloved son (Pete Jr.), and his sister (Juanita Hernandez).
