It is with deep sorrow that the family announces the death of Rosario S. Munoz on October 31, 2022. Charito, as she was affectionately known was born on April 2, 1951 in McAllen to Juan and Felipita Sanchez. She was a woman blessed with a loving and supportive family, grounded in strong Catholic Faith.

Charito was a 1969 graduate of McAllen High School and pursued a Bachelor's Degree from both Pan American University and St. Mary's University in San Antonio where she graduated from in 1973. She also received her Master's Degree in Counseling from Pan American University. Even though Rosario did not plan to embark on a career in education, she accumulated more than 30 illustrious years as a teacher and counselor for the following school districts: La Joya I.S.D., Austin I.S.D., Weslaco I.S.D., The Catholic Diocese in Corpus Christi, Corpus Christi I.S.D., Valley View ISD., Mission C.I.S.D. and was a part time instructor at UTRGV in the student teacher program.

Charito was devoted to her faith and was active in the ministry at Sacred Heart Church in McAllen where she served as a lector, Eucharistic Minister, C.C.D.
